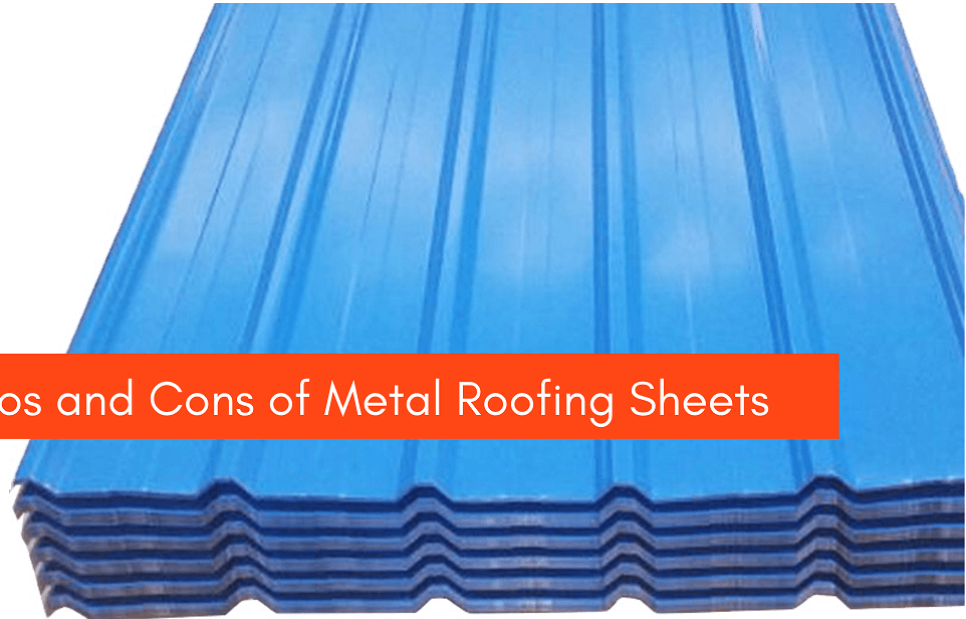

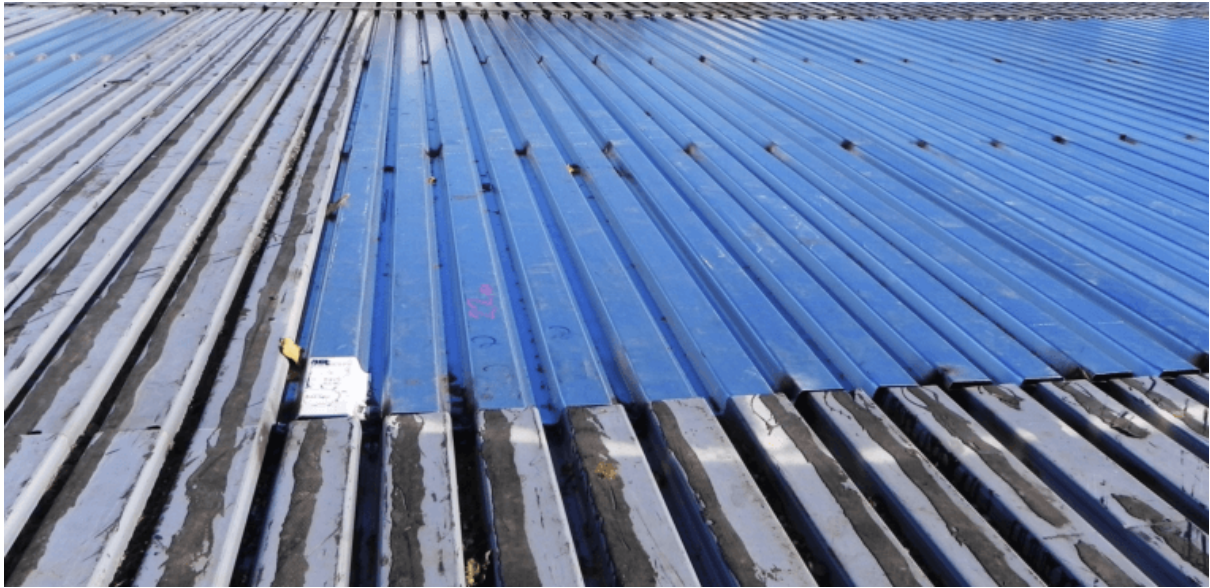
#2 - Colour Metal roofs are eco-friendly.

#2 - Metal roofs can be dented.

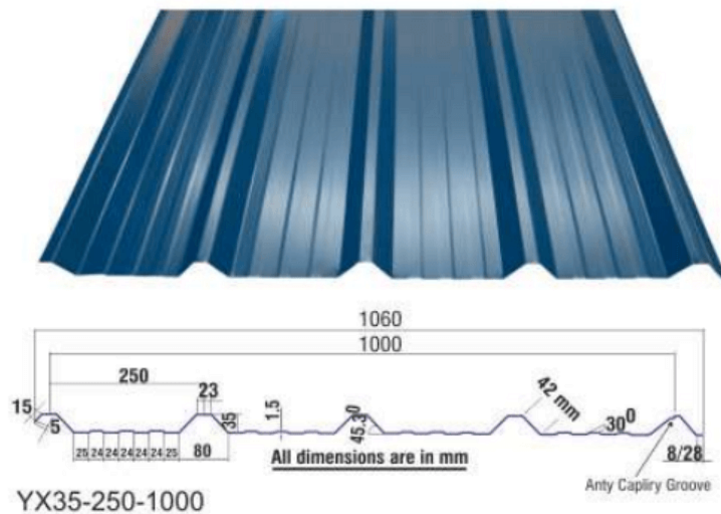

Yes, it is a fact that metal roofs can be noisier than other types of roofing, especially when we refer to heavy rains or thunderstorms. But extra layers of solid sheathing or insulation installed beneath the same will reduce the sound heard inside the construction.

Noise created by rain on metal roofs can be avoided by insulating it from bottom either with PUF or with EPS insulation.
